

On motion by Mr. Johnson,

The house took up for consideration the amendments proposed by the senate, to the bill, entitled, An act further to amend the act incorporating the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company.

The said amendments were then read the second time, severally assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed;

The bill from the senate, entitled, An act to incorporate the Annapolis Rail Road Company;

Also, the bill, entitled, An act relating to the grade of the square of Washington Monument, in the city of Baltimore;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, rejected, and returned to the senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Brawner, from the committee on grievances and courts of justice, entitled, An act for the benefit of Ann Kennard, of Queen Anne's county,

And, the bill reported by Mr. Billingsley, entitled, An act supplementary to an act, for marking and bounding lands;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

On motion by Mr. Thomas, of Cecil,

Ordered, That he have leave to withdraw from the files of the house; the petition praying for the repeal of the commissioners law, in Cecil county;

And, also a petition praying that the county may be levied on to pay for the building of a bridge over the Big Elk Creek, in the town of Elkton.

On motion by Mr. Teackle,

Ordered, That the memorials and petitions of a great number of persons, of different counties, praying the establishment of a state Bank be withdrawn from the files of the house.

Mr. Teackle submitted the following resolutions—

By the House of Delegates,

March 14th, 1832.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the treasurer of the western shore, pay to the honorable John B. Morris, the sum of seventeen dollars, the amount due him for itinerant charges, and to each member of the Senate and House of Delegates, and their officers who may be present, the per diem allowance to which they are respectively entitled, since the closing of the journal of accounts, up to the 16th instant inclusive.
