That so much thereof as relates to "the propriety of es tablishing a State Bank," be referred to the select committee heretofore appointed on that subject.

That so much thereof as relates to education, and the deaf and dumb children, be referred to the standing com-

mittee on education.

That so much thereof as relates to internal improvement, be referred to the standing committee on that subject.

That so much thereof as relates to the inspection of flour

be referred to the standing committee on inspections.

That so much thereof as relates to Lotteries, be referred to the standing committee on Lotteries.

That so much thereof as relates to the report of the Adjutant General, and the militia, be referred to the standing committe on the militia.

That so much thereof as relates to the report of the Board of Managers, for removing the free people of color from this state, be referred to the standing committee heretofore appointed on that subject.

That so much thereof as relates to the five per cent. stock issued by the Executive, be referred to the standing com-

mittee on ways and means.

That so much thereof as relates to the Penitentiary, be

referred to the committee on crimes and punishments.

That so much thereof as relates to communications from the respective states of Pennsylvania, Virginia and Delaware, also a report and resolutions of the General Assembly of New Hampshire, and a communication from the Collector of the Port of Baltimore, be referred to the joint select committee hetetofore appointed on the ordinance of the Convention of South Carolina.

And, that so much thereof as relates to a resolution, directing the Executive to procure a sword for the late gallant Capt. George W. Rogers, be referred to a select com-

mittee.
