By the House of Delegates,
February 1st, 1833.

Gentlemen of the Senate.

We have received your message proposing that no new business except of the most "urgent nature" be originated after the 10th inst. We conceive, that we have been sent here to attend to all business, which may be presented for our action, whether deemed urgent or otherwise; and the adoption of the message might amount to a restriction of the rights of the citizens of this state to petition the Legislature at all times. We therefore dissent from your proposition.
