Which was read. And,

On motion by Mr. Harper, five hundred copies were ordered to be printed, under the superintendance of the Librarian.

Mr. Gantt, chairman of the committee on inspections, made an unfavourable report upon the order of the house, requiring them to enquire into the expediency of authorising the inspection of salted bacon, cured or brought into the city of Baltimore.

Which was read

Mr. Jump reported a bill, entitled, an act for the relief of Daniel Orrell and others of Caroline county.

Which was read the first and second time by special order, and passed.

Mr. Wright of Dorchester, reported a bill, entitled, an act to alter and change the name of Samuel Raitt Creighton of Dorchester county. And,

Mr. Johns reported a bill, entitled, an act authorising the commissioners of Harford county, to levy a sum of money for purposes therein mentioned.

Which were severally read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion by Mr. Bourke, the house took up for consideration the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to alter the time of the meeting of the general assembly of this state and for other purposes.

The said bill was then read the second time, and rejected.

The house resumed the unfinished business of yesterday being the bill reported by Mr. Teackle from the committee on ways and means, entitled, a further additional supplement to an act of December session, 1827, chapter 117, entitled, an act to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinaries, and others.

On motion by Mr. Teackle, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

On motion by Mr. Harris, the house took up for consideration the report of the committee of grievances and courts of justice, relative to a work on the testamentary law of the state of Maryland; proposed to be published by the Honourable Clement Dorsey, associate judge of the first judicial district, and the amendment proposed by Mr. Nicols, to strike out the words "two hundred," and insert "one hundred and fifty."
