The bill reported by Mr. Jenkins, entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore snuff mill company;

Also the bill reported by him, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, an act to incorporate the Warren manufacturing company;

The bill reported by Mr. Compton, chairman of the committee on divorces, entitled, an act to divorce George Twilly and Priscilla Twilly of Worcester county;

And the bill reported by Mr. Powell, entitled, an act to incorporate the Somerset and Worcester Rail Road Company;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.

The favourable reports of the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims, upon the petitions of Adam Hoops, a captain in the revolution, Stephen Fennell a revolutionary soldier, and Harriet Williams, widow of Capt. Elisha Williams, a revolutionary officer;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, the reports concurred in, and the resolutions therein contained, severally assented to.

The preamble and resolution submitted by Mr. Turner on the 31st ultimo, relative to authorising the Register of the Land Office, to record certain proprietary leases;

Was taken up for consideration.

On motion by Mr. Turner, said resolution was amended, by striking out from the word "compensation," in the seventh line, to the end of said resolution, and inserting in lieu thereof, the following in these words, "therefor, to the said Register to be paid out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury, as he is by law entitled to receive for like services."
