

Mr. Gantt moved to amend said bill by adding at the end thereof as an additional section the following—

“And be it enacted, that nothing contained in this act shall extend to Prince George’s county.”

Mr. Harris moved to strike out the enacting clause of the bill.

Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion by Mr. Jenkins,

The bill reported by him entitled, An act to incorporate the Chatsworth Water Company of Baltimore, was taken up for consideration.

On the question being put, shall the said bill pass;

It was resolved in the affirmative.

The preamble and resolutions submitted by Mr. Forman, in relation to opening the navigation through the Sounds, between the Capes of Virginia and Delaware, was taken up for consideration.

On motion by Mr. Forman, said resolutions were amended by adding at the end thereof the following—

*Resolved*, That should the President of the United States at the request of the Governor of this State, designate an Engineer, to make the contemplated survey, that this state, with the states of Virginia and Delaware, or either of them, will pay for the service of such Engineer.

The said resolutions were then read the second time as amended, and assented to.

The resolution submitted by Mr. Mudd, in favor of Elizabeth Downing, widow of the late Dutter Downing, a revolutionary soldier, was taken up for consideration, read the second time, and assented to.

The report and resolutions submitted by Mr. Pratt, from the committee on grievances and courts of justice, relative to the transcribing of certain records in the office of the clerk of the court of appeals, was taken up for consideration, read the second time, the report concurred in, and the resolution therein contained assented to.

The bill reported by Mr. Ely, entitled, An act to repeal an act, passed at December session, 1827, chapter 83;

The bill reported by Mr. Schley, entitled, An act for the benefit of the children and devisees of Henry Steiner, late of Frederick county deceased.

The bill reported by Mr. Jump, entitled, A further additional supplement to an act, entitled, An act for the distribution of a certain fund, for the purpose of establishing free schools, in the several counties therein named, and for other purposes;
