

The bill reported by Mr. Hammond, entitled, An act to authorise the sale of a Lot of ground in the town of Westminster;

Also, the bill reported by him, entitled, an act to authorise the Levy court of Frederick county, to allow additional compensation to John P. Schuyler and for other purposes;

The bill reported by Mr. Wright, of Queen Anne's, entitled, An act for the relief of Bernard Henry, late of the city of Baltimore;

The bill reported by Mr. Weast, entitled, An act to close part of a certain alley, in the town of Hagerstown.

The bill reported by Mr. Wright of Queen Anne's, entitled, an act to incorporate the Beaverdam and Harringtons Branch Canal company.

The bill reported by Mr. Mann, entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Washington county, to levy upon the assessable property of said county, a sum or sums of money, in cases of epidemics.

The bill reported by Mr. Jenkins, entitled, an act relating to the last will and testament of Mary Elizabeth Clouet, of the city of Baltimore.

The bill reported by Mr. Somerville, entitled, an act for the relief of Walter Wells, one of the securities of Thomas R. Wells, deceased, and late collector of taxes for Calvert county. And,

The bill reported by Mr. Harper, chairman of the committee on the coloured population, entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, An act relating to the people of colour in this state, passed at December session 1831; chapter 281.

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.

The bill reported by Mr. Harper, chairman of the committee on the coloured population, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act relating to the free negroes and slaves, passed at December session 1831, chapter 323, was taken up for consideration.

On motion by Mr. White, said bill was amended, by inserting after the word "hired;" in the fifth line, first section; the words "or loaned."

Mr. Turner moved to amend said bill, by inserting after the word "time," in the eleventh line, first section, the following:—
