Mr. Louthan reported a bill, entitled, an act to authorise the sale of certain real estate therein mentioned.

And, Mr. Kent reported a bill, entitled, an act for the relief of Joseph Wood, former sheriff of Calvert county.

Which were severally read the first and second time by special order, and passed.

On motion by Mr. Millbourne, the speaker appointed Mr. Garrettson, on the committee on engrossed bills, to supply the vacancy occasioned by the absence of Mr. Dennis.

Mr. Hollman reported a bill entitled, an act to explain and amend an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company, under the name of the Washington county bank, at the town of Williamsport, in Washington county.

Mr. Roberts reported a bill entitled, an act to repeal part an act, passed December session, 1824, chapter 167, authorising gates to be kept on the public roads, in Queen Ann's county.

Mr. Hollman reported a bill, entitled, an act incorporating a company to make a turnpike road from Williamsport to Hagerstown.

Mr. Wright, of Queen Ann's, reported a bill, entitled, a further additional supplement to an act to enlarge the bounds of Centreville, und for other purposes.

Mr. Turner reported a bill, entitled, an act to make public a certain road therein mentioned.
