The bill reported by Mr. Sutton, entitled, an act to authorise the granting writs of Replevin by justices of the peace and for other purposes therein mentioned;

Was taken up for consideration, when on motion by Mr. Sutton, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Jones of Baltimore, entitled, an act to incorporate the People's Gas Light Company of Baltimore, was taken up for consideration;

When on motion by Mr. Peregoy, the said bill was re-committed to the committee which reported it.

On motion by Mr. Gantt, the bill reported by him, entitled, an act to provide for the inspection of plaster of paris in the town of Bladensburg, was taken up for consideration, read the second time by special order and passed.

On motion by Mr. Lantz, the house proceeded to take up for consideration the bill from the Senate, entitled a further supplement to an act entitled, an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of "The Cumberland Bank of Allegany."

Mr. Scott moved to amend the said bill by striking out the 4th section.

Determined in the negative.

The said bill was then read a second time and passed.

The clerk of the Senate delivered a bill originated and passed by the Senate, entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act relating to Parkin street, in the City of Baltimore;

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Peregoy, Hillen and Carroll.
