

Mr. Roberts from the committee on education reported a bill, entitled an act supplementary to the acts relating to, the University of Maryland.

Mr. Moores reported a bill, entitled, an act relating to the Public lots, in the town of Belle Air, in Harford county;

And, Mr. Blakistone chairman of the committee on grievances and courts of justice; reported a bill, entitled, an act, relative to the plea of limitation;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Hurtt, entitled, an act relating to division fences, between different proprietors in Kent county;

The bill reported by Mr. Roberts, entitled, an act to repeal so much of the act of December session 1823, as relates to the lands of Sarah Wilkinson, of Queen Anne's county;

And, the bill reported by Mr. Johns, chairman of the committee on divorces, entitled, an act to divorce Francisna Kidd; from her husband James Taylor Kidd;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed;

The bill reported by Mr. Nicols, entitled, an act regulating fences in Dorchester county, was taken up for consideration;

On motion by Mr. Burchenal, said bill was amended by inserting after the word Dorchester wherever it occurs, the words 'and Caroline counties.'

The said bill was then read a second time as amended, and passed.

On motion by Mr. Handy, the amendments proposed by the senate to the bill, entitled, an act concerning guardians and wards, were read the second time and assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

Mr. Harris from the committee on corporations, to which was referred the bill from the Senate. entitled, an act to incorporate the Patapsco Female Institute, reported the same with the following amendments.

In the last line, 5th section, strike out the word "as," and insert in lieu thereof the following proviso: "Provided nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to prevent either party from appealing to the county court as is now allowed;"

Which was read and ordered to lie on the table.
