

On motion by Mr. Snowden, the house proceeded to take up for consideration the bill from the Senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the Patapsco Female Institute.

The amendment proposed by the committee to said bill was then read a second time and assented to.

The said bill was then read a second time by special order and passed with the proposed amendment, and returned to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Palmer, entitled, an act authorising the Levy Court of Frederick county to levy a sum of money to erect a bridge over Toms creek, near the village of Emmittsburg;

And the bill reported by Mr. Sellman, entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Anne Arundel county to levy a sum of money sufficient to erect a bridge at the cove in said county;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

The hour having arrived for taking up the order of the day, the house proceeded to take up for consideration the bill reported by Mr. Burchenal, entitled, an act to establish magistrates' district courts in this state, and prescribing their powers and duties, being the order of the day;

When Mr. Merrick moved that the said bill be re-committed to the select committee already appointed on that subject;

Upon which the question was put and resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. Unkefer reported a bill, entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled, an act to confirm an act entitled, an act to alter and repeal all such parts of the constitution and form of government as relates to the division of Frederick county into twelve election districts, and for other purposes, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 112, and confirmed by the act of 1832, chapter 165;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion by Mr. M. F. Smith,

Leave was given to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act to repeal an act, entitled, an act to provide for the repairs of the public roads in Calvert county, passed at December session, 1832, chapter 223, and for other purposes.

Ordered that Messrs. M. F. Smith, Laveille and Wailes report the same.
