

The bill from the senate entitled, an act to extend to the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail-road company, certain privileges and powers heretofore granted to the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road company, was taken up for consideration, read the second time, rejected and returned to the senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Hillen, entitled, an act further supplemental to the act entitled, an act relating to insolvent debtors, in the city and county of Baltimore;

Was taken up for consideration.

Mr. Merriek moved to strike out the enacting clause of the bill.

On which the question was put, and resolved in the affirmative.

So the bill was rejected.

Mr. Wright, of Dorchester, submitted the following resolution:

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the western shore, pay to Louis Gassaway, chief clerk to the House of Delegates, five dollars, being the amount paid by him for printing circulars, ordering the members of the Legislature to be furnished with newspapers, during the present session.*

Which was read the first and second time by special order, assented to, and sent to the senate.
