

Mr. Handy moved to amend the bill, by inserting after the word 'cause,' in the 2d line of the 1st section, the words 'to be instituted in Baltimore county court,' determined in the negative.

The said bill was then passed and returned to the senate. Also, a bill, entitled, a further supplement to the act, entitled, an act relating to the people of colour in this state; Which was read the first and second time by special order; passed and returned to the senate.

And, a resolution requiring the geologist appointed by act of assembly, to make a survey of the state, to deposit the specimens he may collect, in certain literary institutions; Which was read the first and second time by special order, assented to, and returned to the senate;

And returned the bill, entitled, an act, making it penal to sell a certain description of property, under certain circumstances, endorsed, 'will pass,' with the proposed amendments, Which amendments were read the first and second time by special order, assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed;

And, returned the resolution in favor of Edward Du-bois, and others; The resolution in favor of William McNeir, and Jeremiah Hughes; The resolution in favor of Louis Cassaway; The resolution relative to the Public Lands, westward of Fort Cumberland;

The resolution in favor of Theodore Mitchell; The resolution in favor of Claude, and Hammond; And, the resolution in favor of William McNeir, Severally endorsed, assented to, ordered to be engrossed;

And also, the journal of accounts, endorsed, assented to. And delivered the resolution, relative to the Maryland Hospital, heretofore rejected by this house, accompanied with the following message:
