Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

Mr. Dorsey submitted the following order,

Ordered, That the committee on printing be instructed to contract with the printer on the following terms.

That when any communication, report or other document, communicated to both houses, shall be ordered to be printed by the house, the clerk shall ascertain whether the same has been previously ordered by the Senate, if so, the copies shall be furnished by the printer to the Senate for the use of house, under the joint contract of the two houses now in force. And when the same person shall be printer to both houses of the Legislature, and any communication, report, or other document communicated to both houses, and printed by the house, the printer shall charge for the same at the rate allowed by the joint contract for press work, including paper, folding, stitching, and excluding composition.

Which was read, and on motion of Mr. Ely, ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Ely then submitted the following message:
