Mr. Turner of Calvert, submitted the following message which was read, and assented to.

By the House of Delegates,
January 5, 1835.

Gentlemen of the Senate:

A vacancy having occurred in the office of Register of Wills, for Calvert County, it was temporarily supplied by the Executive, until the meeting of the General Assembly. We therefore propose with the concurrence of your honorable body, to proceed to make the appointment, on Thursday, the 8th inst, of a person who shall be recommended to his Excellency, the Governor of Maryland, to be commissioned as Register of Wills for the said county, in accord-
