Which amendments were twice read and assented to.

Mr. Cushing moved farther to amend said bill, by adding at the end thereof, as an additional section, the following:

Sec. 11. And be it enacted, That if at any time hereafter the corporate property of the company by this act created, shall be found insufficient to pay and satisfy all just demands against said company for debts contracted, or liabilities incurred, then the stockholders for the time being, as also those persons who were stockholders at the time such debt was contracted, or liability incurred, shall in their individual capacities be jointly and severally bound to pay and make good all such deficiency.

Determined in the negative.
