Mr. Moores presented a memorial of Jacob H. Munnikhuisen, relative to a further supplement to the act, entitled, an act relating to the recording of deeds, passed at December session, 1831;

And, Mr. Brengle presented a memorial of sundry citizens of Frederick county, relative to the jurisdiction of magistrates;

Which were severally read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

Mr. Nicols presented a memorial of sundry citizens of Dorchester county, praying an appropriation from the state, for the improvement of the navigation of the 'Transquakin river;

Which was read and referred to the committee on internal improvement.

Mr. Worthington presented a petition of sundry citizens of Prince George's county, praying that Ann Curtain may be placed on the pension roll of said county;

Which was read and referred to the committee on pensions to indigent persons by county assessment.

Mr. Pratt presented a report of the commissioners appointed to lay off the 5th election district of Prince George's county, into school districts;

Which was read and referred to the committee on education.

On motion of Mr. Hambleton of Talbot,

Ordered, That the committee on pensions by county assessment, be instructed to inquire into the expediency of placing Nancy McNeal of Talbot county, upon the pension roll of said county.

On motion of Mr. Gaither,

Ordered, That the committee on pensions to indigent persons by county assessment, inquire into the expediency of placing Francis Simpson, of Montgomery county upon the pension roll of said county.

Mr. Hearn obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, an act to authorise the levy court of Worcester county, to furnish a ferry boat at Pollitt's ferry, in Worcester and Somerset counties;

Ordered, That Messrs. Hearn, Bevans, and Gillis, report the same.
