Gentlemen,

I have to day had the honour of receiving your communication of the 7th, by government express, informing me that I have been "appointed to the senate of the United States, to supply the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of the Honourable Ezekiel F. Chambers."

This distinguished evidence of the favour and confidence of the General Assembly of Maryland, fills me with the most gratifying emotions, and I accept the trust at their hands with all becoming respectfulness.

The severity of the frost, which has delayed your express on his route, renders it uncertain what course I must take to pass to the other side of the Chesapeake Bay. I will endeavour to be at Annapolis on my way to the seat of the Federal Government with all convenient despatch, delaying no further time than is absolutely necessary for my own private arrangements preparatory to leaving home.
