day, the house again resolved itself into a committee of the

whole house, and resumed the consideration of the unfinished

order of yesterday, being the report and resolutions submitted

by Mr. Merrick, chairman of the special committee, in

relation to the southern and western boundaries of this

State, and after some time spent therein, the Speaker resumed

the chair, when Mr. Nicols, the chairman, reported that said

committee had, according to order, had the said report and

resolutions again under consideration, and having adopted

sundry amendments to the report, he was directed to report

the same to the house, with the said report, and to ask

that the said committee be discharged from the further

consideration of the subject;

Whereupon, the said committee of the whole house was

accordingly discharged;

Amendments proposed by the committee of the whole

house:

1st. Strike out the 2d and 3d resolutions, and insert the

following:

Resolved, That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized

and required, to transmit a copy of the above resolution,

without unnecessary delay, to his Excellency the Governor

of Virginia, and also to communicate to the Governor of

Maryland, to close and finally adjust this long pending question

by amicable negotiation.

2d. Strike out the Report.

The said amendments were read the first time;

And, on motion,

The house then adjourned until tomorrow morning at 10

o'clock.
