Resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. Cushing obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled,
an act to incorporate the Baltimore Musical Association;
Ordered, That Messrs. Cushing, Jones of Baltimore, and
Wyse, report the same.

Mr. Jones of Baltimore, obtained leave to bring in a bill,
entitled, an act to incorporate the Philveretan Society of
Baltimore;

Ordered, That Messrs. Jones of Baltimore, Cushing, and
Shower, report the same.

Mr. Gillis obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, an act
to provide for the improvement of a portion of the county
road therein mentioned, in Worcester county;

Ordered, That Messrs. Gillis, Hearn and Bevans, report
the same.

Mr. Dorsey asked leave to bring in a bill, entitled, an act
to prevent the useless accumulation of costs arising from
the publication of notices of orders passed by the courts or
the judges of such counties wherein no newspaper is edited.

Mr. Scott moved to refer said leave to the committee on
grievances and courts of justice.

Mr. Dorsey moved to refer it to a select committee.
The question was first put on referring said leave to the
committee on grievances and courts of justice;
Determined in the negative.
