Which was read and referred to the committee on corporations.

The Speaker also laid before the house, a report from the clerk of the Court of Appeals, for the western shore, relative to the attendance of the Judges.

Which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

On motion of Mr. McMahon;

Ordered, That the petition of sundry inhabitants of the 2d election district, in Allegany county, praying the passage of an act, authorising Doctor William Frey, of Pennsylvania, to practice medicine in said district, without being licensed to practice, be withdrawn from the files of the house.

Mr. Kershner obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Antietam Fire Company, in Hargerstown, Washington county

Ordered, That Messrs. Kershner, West and Welty, report the same.

Mr. Cottman asked leave to bring in a bill, to be entitled, an act to carry into effect the provisions of an act to provide for the public instruction of youth in primary schools, throughout this state.

Which was read and on motion of Mr. Cottman, referred to the committee on education.

On motion of Mr. Bevans;

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, report to this house, the number and names of all the Academies, Colleges and Schools, in this State, which receive donations, and the amount of donation given to each.

Mr. Jones, of Somerset, chairman of the committee on grievances and courts of justice, to which was referred the petition of Jacob H. Munnikhuyzen, praying the passage of a supplement to the act, entitled, an act relating to the recording of deeds, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 304.

Also, an order of the house of the 19th inst., requiring them to enquire into the expediency of repealing the second
