

On motion of Mr. Sutton, the house took up for consideration, the bill reported by him from the committee on pensions by county assessment, entitled, an act relating to county pensioners;

On motion of Mr. Hughes, said bill was amended, by adding as an additional section to the bill, the following:

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That all laws or parts of laws inconsistent with or repugnant to the provisions of this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

Mr. Ely moved further to amend said bill, by adding as an additional section, the following:

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act shall be so construed as to apply to Baltimore county;

Which was read.

Mr. Burchenal moved to amend said amendment, by inserting after the word "Baltimore," the word "Caroline;" Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion of Mr. Gantt, said amendment was further amended by inserting "Prince Georges."

On motion of Mr. Iglehart, "Anne Arundel," was inserted.

On motion of Mr. West, "Washington," was inserted.

On motion of Mr. McMahon, "Alleghany," was inserted.

On motion of Mr. Sothoron, "St. Mary's" was inserted.

Mr. Cushing moved to recommit the bill and amendments to the committee;

Resolved in the affirmative.

The hour having arrived for taking up the order of the day, the house proceeded to consider the report of the committee of the whole house, in relation to the southern and western boundaries of this State.

On motion of Mr. Merrick, the house was called and the door keeper sent for the absent members.

On motion of Mr. Jones of Somerset, the house resolved to proceed with the ordinary business of the session during the absence of the doorkeeper.

On motion of Mr. Cushing, the bill reported by him, entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore Musical Association, was taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, an act for the benefit of John Mourey, of Washington county;

Also, the bill, entitled, an act authorising the Levy court of Frederick county, to levy a sum of money for purposes therein mentioned;
