

Mr. Jones of Somerset, submitted the following reso-

lution,
Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That
the Treasurer of the Western Shore be, and he is hereby
authorised and required, to pay to Samuel T. Moore, or
order, the sum of money due to his father, William Moore,
of Somerset county, at the time of his death, in virtue of a
resolution of the Legislature, granting a pension to said
Moore.

Which was read the first and second time by special or-

der, assented to, and sent to the senate.

Mr. Brengle, from the select committee, delivered the fol-

lowing report:
The special committee to whom was referred the memori-
al of the grand and petit jurors, of Frederick County Court
at its last December session, representing that compensation
ought to be made Frederick A. Schley, Esq., for his servi-
ces rendered the state as counsel by appointment of court,
in the case of the state, vs. Joseph O'Connor, beg leave to
report that they have had the same under consideration, and
that the said Frederick A. Schley, ought to be paid a fair
compensation for said services, and for this purpose, re-
specially submit the following resolution:

Resolved, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That
the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay to Frederick A.
Schley, or order, out of any unappropriated money in the
Treasury, the sum of fifty dollars, for services rendered the
State.

Which was read the first time, and on motion of Mr. Ely,

referred to the committee on claims.

Mr. Johns, chairman of the committee on divorces, re-

ported a bill, entitled, an act to divorce Zachariah Webster
and Mildred, his wife;

And, Mr. Jones, of Somerset, chairman of the committee
on grievances and courts of justice, reported a bill, entitled,
an act to require Justices of the Peace to compute the time
for the stay of execution under supersedeas, from the rendi-

tion of the judgment;
Which were severally read the first time, and ordered to
lie on the table.

Mr. Williams reported a bill, entitled, an act to divide
Worcester county, into school districts, to regulate the dis-

tribution of the Free School Fund of said county, and for
the promotion of education therein;
Which was read the first time, and
