Ordered, That the treasurer of the western shore communicate to this house a statement of the free school fund for Charles county, shewing the receipts and several amounts applied to the fund for said county, from the tax on bank stock, the amounts received from dividends of stock invested to the credit of said county fund, the amounts received and applied to the fund for said county, by the distribution of the county school fund, and the receipts on account of that fund, and the distribution of common free school fund, and the receipts from such part of said fund as has been distributed to said county fund, and also the several amounts paid to the commissioners for said county, and the several amounts invested to the credit of all the free school fund for Charles county,
