

And, on motion of Mr. Dorsey, five hundred copies ordered to be printed.

The clerk of the Senate returned the bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Weyerton Manufacturing Company, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments," which amendments were severally read the first time;

And, 'on motion of Mr. Jones of Baltimore, ordered to be printed;

And, delivered a bill, originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled, an act supplementary to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate the American Life Insurance and Trust Company;

Which was read and referred to the committee on corrections.

Also, a bill entitled, a further supplement to the act, entitled, an act directing the manner of suing out attachments in this province, and limiting the extent of them;

Which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

Mr. Johns reported a bill, entitled, an act to appoint Mary Jordan of Harford county, trustee for the sale of certain land therein mentioned;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The house then adjourned, until tomorrow morning, 10 o'clock.

FRIDAY, February 6th, 1835.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The Speaker laid before the house a report of the trustees of Prince Frederick town Academy, relative to the condition of said academy;

Which was read and referred to the committee on education.

Also, laid before the house a memorial of sundry citizens of St. Mary's county, in relation to the county roads;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Fowler, Sothoron, and Dorsey.

Mr. Annan presented a petition of Margaret Callahan, of Frederick county, praying to be divorced from her husband Patrick Callahan;

Which was read and referred to the committee on divorces.
