

SATURDAY, February 7th, 1835.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Mr. Harding presented a petition of Eleanor Parsley, of Montgomery county, praying the passage of an act authorising the levy court of said county to place her on the pension list of said county;

Mr. Roberts of Queen Anne's, presented a petition of William Everett, of Queen Anne's county;

And, Mr. Gantt presented a petition of Mary Carrick, of Prince George's county, severally praying to be placed on the pension list of said counties;

Which were severally read and referred to the committee on pensions to indigent persons by county assessment.

Mr. Moores presented a memorial of William Brierly of Harford county, praying that the heirs of J. B. Biddle may be released from the payment of certain money therein mentioned;

Which was read and referred to the committee on claims. Mr. Moores also presented a petition of sundry citizens of Harford county, praying that Scott Preston may be placed on the pension roll of said county;

Which was read and referred to the committee on pensions to indigent persons by county assessment.

Mr. Kershner presented a petition of James Gallion, of Washington county, praying to be divorced from his wife Margaret Gallion;

Which was read and referred to the committee on divorces.

Mr. Cushing presented a memorial of sundry creditors of the Bank of Maryland, praying the passage of an act for their relief;

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

Mr. Duvall presented a petition of sundry citizens of Frederick county, praying for a modification of the law, passed at December session, 1833, relative to the travelling on the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road;

Which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject—and,

Mr. Moores presented a petition of sundry inhabitants of the town of Belle Air, in Harford county, praying the passage of an act authorising them to raise, by lottery, a sum of money to pave the streets of said town;
