That for the branch of the Farmers' Bank of Maryland, at Easton, James Price, William Hughlett, and Thomas Hayward.

That for the Elkton Bank, Adam Whann.

That for the Hagers' Town Bank, Daniel Weisel, and Alexander Neill, Sen.

Mr. Merrick moved to reconsider the motion submitted by him this morning, postponing until tomorrow the order of the day, being the bill reported by him from the committee on ways and means, entitled, an act to incorporate the Merchants' Bank of Baltimore;

Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion of Merrick, the house then took up for consideration said bill.

Mr. Teackle moved to amend said bill, by striking out in the second section, ninth line, after the word 'and,' the word 'fifty,' and inserting in lieu thereof, the word 'forty;'
