Which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. Gantt presented a petition of sundry citizens of Prince George's county, praying that Archibald Beall and Ellen Beall, of said county, may be placed on the pension roll of said county;

Which was read and referred to the committee on pensions to indigent persons by county assessment.

Mr. Ridgely obtained leave to bring in a bill, to alter and amend an act, entitled, an act to reduce into one, the several acts of Assembly, respecting elections, and to regulate said elections, passed December session, 1832, chapter 275;

Ordered, That Messrs. Ridgely, Igichart and Brewer, report the same.

Mr. Kirby submitted the following resolution:

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the donation heretofore paid to the Washington College, in Kent county, shall hereafter be divided in the following manner, viz:—

To the Washington College, at Chestertown, five hundred dollars, and to the Millington Academy, three hundred dollars, and the Treasurer of the Western Shore, is hereby authorised and required to pay the said donation to the Trustees of the aforesaid College and Academy, or their order, annually hereafter; and the Trustees of said Academy, are hereby required to cause to be educated, three indigent children, for each hundred dollars so received.

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Hood submitted the following resolution:

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Armourer at Annapolis, be and he is hereby required to deliver to Capt. Grafton D. Spurrier, such arms and accoutrements as said Spurrier may select, not exceeding sixty of each, on said Spurrier's giving such bond for the faithful return of the same, as the Governor and Council may require.

Which was read the first and second time by special order, assented to and sent to the senate.

Mr. Beckett, chairman of the committee on claims, made an unfavorable report upon the memorial of the grand and petit jurors of Frederick county, accompanied with the report of the special committee on that subject, giving to
