So the amendment was rejected,

Mr. Jones of Balt. moved that the house adjourn,  
Which motion he waived for the purpose of allowing the  
following message from the senate to be announced,

The clerk of the senate, returned the bill, entitled, an  
act supplementary to an act passed at December session,  
1833, chapter 250, endorsed, "will pass," ordered to be  
engrossed,

Also, the bill, entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an  
act to authorise the trustees of the poor of Dorchester  
county, to purchase a farm for the use of the poor and to  
sell the present Alms House of said county, and for other  
purposes, passed March 9th 1832, endorsed, "will pass  
with the proposed amendment," which amendment was  
twice read, assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed,  
Also, the resolution in favor of James Raymond, endors-  
ed, assented to, ordered to be engrossed,

And, delivered, a bill originated in and passed by the se-  
nate entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act for  
the reassessment and revaluation of all the real and perso-  
nal property in Allegany county,

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Beall, McMahon,  
and Devemon,

Also, a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Elkton Li-  
brary Company,  
Which was read and referred to the committee on cor-  
porations,

The house then adjourned until tomorrow morning ten  
o'clock.
