

THURSDAY, February 12th, 1835.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Mr. Gittings presented three memorials of sundry citizens of Montgomery county, relating to the fisheries on the Potomac river;

Which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. Nelson presented a petition of the Trustees of Little Creek Academy, in Harford county, praying that a portion of the donation which is now given to the Belle Air Academy, may be withdrawn and placed to the said Little Creek Academy.

Mr. Devecmon presented two memorials of sundry citizens of Allegany county, praying a law to prevent trespass west of Savage river, in said county.

Which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. Orrick presented a petition of sundry citizens of Baltimore county, praying for the passage of an act, authorising the building of a bridge over the great falls of Gunpowder, at Monkton Mills.

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Orrick, Ely, Wyse, Moores, and Nelson.

Mr. Moores presented a memorial of Zephaniah Bayless, praying the passage of an act, authorising Harford County court to confirm the proceedings of certain commissioners therein mentioned;

Which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

And, Mr. Trundle presented a petition of Jane F. Byrd, of the State of Virginia, praying the passage of an act authorising the sale of certain real estate, therein mentioned;

Which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice:

Mr. Wyse presented a report from the trustees of the Franklin Academy, of Reisterstown, relative to the condition of said Academy;

Which was read and referred to the committee on education.

Ordered, That a committee consisting of seven members of this House, be appointed to examine the records formerly belonging to the office of the Commissary General, now in the custody of the Registrar of Wills, of Anne Arundel
