

Mr. Teackle, from the committee on corporations, to which was referred a bill, entitled, an act to form an association to be entitled, Guillet Gravitation Company, reported the same with the following amendments:

Amendments proposed,

1st. In section 3d, 3d line, after the name of "Guillet," insert the following—"if alive, and not disqualified by age, or other cause."

2d. In section 8, after the word enacted, strike out the residue of the section, and insert the following—"that the said company shall not be permitted to issue any note payable to bearer, or in the nature of a bank note—and that this act shall at any time be subject to modification, or repeal, by the legislature of this State."

2d. Add Sec. 9. And be it enacted, That nothing contained in this act shall be construed to restrict the right of the legislature, which is hereby reserved in its fullest extent, to impose from time to time, and at all times hereafter, and levy such tax, by way of license or otherwise, upon all property, estate or funds, in which the capital of said company hereby incorporated, shall be invested, in common with similar property, estate, or funds, of any other company, corporations, or individuals of this State.

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Thomas reported a bill, entitled, an act relating to two public roads, No. 6 and No. 48, in Queen Anne's county;
