Mr. Gantt moved further to amend said bill, by inserting as the eighth section of the bill, the following:

Section 8. *And be it enacted,* That whenever the State shall become a stockholder to the amount of fifty thousand dollars, she shall be entitled to appoint two directors, and when the State shall be a stockholder to the amount of one hundred thousand dollars, she shall be entitled to three directors, and the election of said directors shall be annually made by joint ballot of both houses, either during the session of the General Assembly, at which such investment shall be made, or at the first session after the State shall so have become a stockholder, to the respective amounts aforesaid; and after the State shall have subscribed and elected directors aforesaid, the stockholders at the next election of directors, shall only elect as many directors as together with the State directors, will amount to the number of twelve.

Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion of Mr. Ely, said bill was further amended by striking out in the eighth section thereof, first line, the word 'day,' and inserting the word 'Monday;'
