Mr. Pratt, then moved that said order be rejected; Resolved in the affirmative.

The Speaker laid before the house reports from the clerks of Frederick and Dorchester county courts, relative to the attendance of Judges;

Which were read and severally referred to the committee

on grievances and courts of justice.

Also, reports from said clerks, relative to the several sums of money paid by them into the public treasury, within the year ending on the 30th, of November;

Which were severally read and referred to the committee

on ways and means.

On motion of Mr. Merrick,

Ordered, that the report and resolutions of the General Assembly of South Carolina, communicated to this house by the Executive, and the correspondence which has passed between the governor of Virginia and the Executive of this State in relation to our South-Western Boundary, be printed for the use of the Legislature.

Mr. Iglehart reported a bill, entitled, an act for the benefit of William Jenkins, former collector of Anne Arundel

county;

Which was read the first and second time by special

order, passed, and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Duvall reported a bill, entitled, an act for the benefit of Thomas H. Clagett, and Charles Gassaway, citizens of Louden county, in the State of Virginia;

And, Mr. Richardson reported a bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Columbia Beneficial society of Maryland;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Teackle submitted the following order;

"Ordered, That a committee to consist of seven[members be appointed to inquire into the expediency of establishing an Agricultural School and Pattern Farm, in each of the counties of this State;"

Which was read;

Mr. Merrick moved to amend said order, by adding at the end thereof, these words, "and to report a plan for providing ways and means to defray the expense thereof;"

Resolved in the affirmative;

The said order was then read the second time as amend-

ed, and adopted.

In pursuance whereof, the Speaker appointed Messrs. Teackle, Annan, Wharton, Gillis, Heard, Larimore, and McCullogh, the Committee.
