

On motion of Mr. Carroll, of St. Mary's,

On motion of Mr. Duckett,  
 Ordered, That the committee on Internal Improvement be, and they are hereby instructed to enquire into the propriety of preparing and reporting to this house, a supplement to the act incorporating the Annapolis and Potomac Canal Company, passed at December session, 1825, chapter 189, which shall provide for the organization of said company, so soon as it shall be determined on the manner prescribed by the act of Congress confirming an act of the Legislature of Maryland, entitled, an act incorporating the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal company, and an act of the State of Maryland confirming the same, approved 3d day of March, 1834, that the canal thereby authorised to be made can be constructed without injury to the navigation of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal, and that said committee report such other amendments to said act as may be necessary for the more efficient organization of the company thereby incorporated.
