

The preamble and resolutions submitted by Mr. Teackle, on the 6th inst. in relation to the establishment of Light Houses at Hoopers Island, near the straits in Dorchester county, and at Sharps Island in Talbot county, was taken up for consideration,

On motion of Mr. Burchenal, said preamble and resolution was amended, by inserting after the word "county," in the fourth line thereof, the following, "and the placing of buoys in the great Choptank river, near Cambridge, on the shoals commonly called the Sugar loaf, and Jamaica shoals,"

On motion of Mr. Burchenal, said preamble and resolution was further amended, by inserting after the word "Islands," in the eleventh line thereof, these words, "and the placing of buoys as above mentioned,"

On motion of Mr. Burchenal, said resolution was further amended, by inserting after the word "county," in the twenty-first line the following "and for placing buoys on the Sugar Loaf and Jamaica Shoals on the great Choptank river,

The said preamble and resolution was then read the second time as amended, and assented to.

The doorkeeper having returned, reported that in obedience to order, he had notified the absent members that their attendance in the House was required,

The House then resumed the consideration of the bill reported by Mr. Richardson, entitled, an act to confirm an act passed December session 1834, chapter 219,

The said bill was then read the second time, and placed in the hands of the chair;

Mr. Winder, moved to withdraw said bill from the hands of the chair;

Determined in the negative.

The question was then put, shall the said bill pass,

Resolved in the affirmative,
