Mr. Berry reported a bill, entitled, an act to regulate constables fees in Allegany county;

Which were severally read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Teackle reported a bill, entitled, an act for the relief of William Adams, of Somerset county;

Which was read the first and second time by special order, passed and sent to the senate.

The bill reported by Mr. McLean, entitled, an act further to continue an act, passed at November session, 1795, entitled, an act to Incorporate an Insurance Company in Baltimore Town, was taken up for consideration,

When on motion of Mr. McLean, said bill was referred to the committee on corporations.

The bill also reported by Mr. McLean, entitled, a supplement to an act passed at December session 1831, entitled an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Chesapeake Steam Towing Company, was taken up for consideration,

When on motion of Mr. McLean, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Willis, entitled, an act for the division of Baltimore and Frederick counties, and for the erecting a new one by the name of "Carroll," and to alter and change the Constitution of this State, so far as may be necessary to effect the same, was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Willis, said bill was laid on the table, and made the order of the day for Wednesday next the 20th instant.

Mr. Carroll, of Baltimore county, chairman of the select committee on the Constitution, delivered the following report:—
