On motion of Mr. Bruff,

Ordered, that the several standing committees of this House, when called upon to meet in morning session by their respective chairmen, will meet at 9 o'clock.

Mr. McMahon obtained leave to bring in a bill, to regulate the mode of distributing the votes and proceedings of the General Assembly of Maryland, and to repeal the acts of Assembly heretofore passed on that subject.

Ordered, that Messrs. McMahon, Winder, Brewer, Bruff and Spence, report the same.

Mr. Carpenter obtained leave to bring in a bill, to be entitled, an act to provide for the division of Charles county, into school districts and the establishment of primary schools therein.

Ordered, that Messrs. Carpenter, Merrick and Spalding, report the same.

Mr. Annan reported a bill, entitled, an act in behalf of Nicholas Brengle and Mary his wife, and their children.

Which was read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Hood submitted the following order,

Ordered, that the select committee, to whom was referred "a petition of sundry citizens of Baltimore and Frederick counties, praying the repeal or amendment, of an act passed at December session 1831, chapter 217; relative to the medical and chirurgical Faculty in this State," be discharged from the further consideration of the subject; and that said petition be referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.
