Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

Also, a communication from the trustees of the University of Maryland, enclosing the annual account of the Treasurer of said University, endorsed, "referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates;"

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Bryan, Wharton

and Gilliss.

And, the following communication from the Executive;
