

On motion of Mr. McLean, said bill was amended, by striking out in the first section, second line, these words,—"to appoint three suitable persons as commissioners, whose duty shall be," and inserting in lieu thereof, the following, "authorize the city commissioners of the city of Baltimore." The said bill was then read the second time as amended, and passed.

The bill, reported by Mr. McLean, entitled, an act to incorporate the Patuxent Company, was taken up for consideration.

When on motion of Mr. McLean, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Carroll, of Baltimore county, entitled, an act to alter and amend an act providing for the appointment of Line Inspectors for the city of Baltimore, and prescribing their duties, was taken up for consideration, When on motion of Mr. Richardson, said bill was laid on the table.

And on motion of Mr. Brown, made the order of the day for Friday next the 22d inst.

The bill reported by Mr. Bayly, chairman of the committee on education, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act for incorporating the Govan's town Academy, in Baltimore county, was taken up for consideration. When on motion of Mr. Gittings, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Sutton, entitled, an act to extend the jurisdiction of justices of the peace in certain cases therein mentioned, was taken up for consideration, When on motion of Mr. Sutton, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The hour having arrived for taking up the order of the day, the House proceeded to consider the bill reported by Mr. Ely, entitled, an act to establish Magistrates' Courts in the several counties of this State, and to prescribe their jurisdiction;

On motion of Mr. Brown, said bill, was postponed to Tuesday, the 26th inst.

On motion of Mr. Teackle, the House took up for consideration the amendment proposed by the Senate, to the preamble and resolution, relative to certain rivers, straits, and sounds—and the message submitted by him on the 19th inst. in relation to that subject.

On the question being put, will the House adopt said message, it was determined in the negative.
