

six persons, two of whom shall reside in each of the commissioners districts hereinbefore designated and described, at the time of the election, and those six persons receiving the greatest number of legal votes and residing in each district as aforesaid, shall be declared duly elected commissioners for Baltimore county—and the voters aforesaid, shall be entitled to elect in the same manner every two years thereafter, three persons, one of whom shall reside in each of the districts aforesaid, to fill the vacancies as herein before provided by this act,

Which was read.

On the question being put, will the house adopt said amendment,

It was determined in the negative.
