At the end of the section, insert "provided always that this act shall not be construed to effect any deed or instrument of writing executed since the 10th of Feb. 1835, and provided also, that in all other respects the said deeds or instruments of writing have been executed, ackonwledged and recorded in conformity with the same, relating to the subject at that time in torce in this State."

Which were read and ordered to lie on the table.
