

Which was read and referred to the committee on pensions to indigent persons by county assessment.

Mr. Lassell presented a petition of William Sappington and others, citizens of Kent county, praying for redress of grievances therein mentioned,

Which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

Mr. Nelson, presented a memorial of sundry citizens of Harford county, praying for a convention to alter and amend the constitution of this State,—And,

Mr. Sutton, presented a memorial of a large number of the citizens of Harford county, praying for a change in the present form of the State government,

Which were severally read and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Frantz presented a memorial of Duff Green and others, praying for the incorporation of a company, for the construction of a Canal or Rail Road, from the town of Cumberland, to a point at or near the mouth of the Savage river,

Which was read and referred to the committee on internal improvements.

Mr. McLean presented a petition of John F. Exe and others, praying for an act to incorporate the German Beneficial Society of Baltimore,

Which was read and referred to the committee on corporations.

Mr. Worthington presented a petition of Mildred B. Webster, of Prince George's county, praying to be divorced from her husband, Zachariah Webster, of Charles county,

Which was read and referred to the committee on divorces.

Mr. Berry presented a petition of sundry citizens of the sixth election district in Allegany county, praying an investigation into the school fund of said county,

Which was read and referred to Messrs, Berry, McMahon, Frantz, Matthews and Brookhart.

The Speaker laid before the house a report from the Treasurer of the Western Shore, in obedience to an order of the House of Delegates, of the 8th of January, 1836, shewing the aggregate amount of revenue paid into the treasury, by each county, the city of Baltimore, and the city of Annapolis, as nearly as can be ascertained in each of the last eight fiscal years,
