On motion of Mr. Duckett,

Ordered, that the committee on Internal Improvements be instructed to enquire into the expediency of authorising a subscription on the part of the State to the capital stock of the Annapolis and Potomae Canal Company, and that the said committee report to this House by bill or otherwise.

On motion of Mr. Brookhart,

Ordered, that the Governor be requested to report to this House whether any report was ever made to the Executive under the resolution of 1825, authorising a revision of the laws, and if made, by whom such report was made, with a copy of the same. Also, what amount of money has been expended by the Executive under that resolution or the resolution passed at the session of 1831, and numbered 79 when, for what, and to whom such money was paid, and whether full compensation had not been made by the Executive for all services rendered by those engaged in the revision of the laws prior to the passage of the resolution No. 63, at December session 1834, and whether since then any additional expenditure has been made under the above nam. ed resolution or any of them, and if so, to what amount, for what service, and to whom paid.
