Resolution authorising the, to cause to be transcribed, such public documents as they may deem worthy, &c. reported, and to compensate therefor, and to draw on the Treasurer for the same, reported 497; assented to 498; sent to the senate 541; returned assented 625.

Resolution authorising the, to settle and adjust all accounts for expences incurred in the survey of the route of a Rail Road along the base of the South Mountain, in Frederick county, proposed and *, 498.

Resolution authorising the, to appoint commissioners to employ an engineer to make survey and estimates of a route for a Rail Road, from the S. line of Delaware, to the N. line of Virginia, through Berlin, Newark, Snow Hill, to Pocomoke river, &c. proposed—amended by authorising first a requisition upon the State engineer for the service, and assented to 525; sent to the senate 540; returned assente o 566.

Resolution authorising the, to compensate the commissioners in assisting the engineer for making a survey of the route for the Rail Road along the base of the south mountain, in Frederick county, proposed and assented to 627; sent to the senate 540.

Resolution authorising the, to contract for and have printed, &c. the Autographic History of Maryland, presented by John Leeds Keer, including Bozman's introduction, &c. proposed 531-2.
