

Fisheries, Order to enquire as to the propriety of allowing free negroes to come into this State for the purpose of assisting at the Shad and Herring, proposed and negatived 180.

Resolution requesting the Governor to appoint four commissioners from each, St. Mary's, Charles, Prince George's, and Montgomery counties, to meet such commissioners as may be appointed by Virginia to examine the, &c- and report to the next legislature some plan for the preservation of the shad and herring fisheries on the Potomac, proposed 402; * 403; resolution amended 483.4 * 484.

Supplement to the act of 1820 ch. 199, more effectually to prevent anchoring of vessels in the, in the Susquehanna river and at the head of the Chesapeake Bay &c. received from the senate 506; postponed till May 702.

Petition of citizens of Kent county for a law to prevent persons from hauling seines on the property of others between high and low water mark, under the penalty of forfeiting boat and seine 472.

Flag, order proposed that the armourer hoist the, in honor of the anniversary of the victory of New Orleans; 47; amendment proposing to insert also the anniversary of the victory of the Thames and Tippecanoe *ib*; subject indefinitely postponed *ib*.

Order that the, be hoisted every day whilst the house is in session, proposed and negatived 49.

Order to hoist the, and fire a salute, in honor of the anniversary of the birth day of the father of his country, proposed 302; adopted 303.

Flanigain, Benjamin, petition of, for a divorce from his wife Christiana Flanigain 408; unfavorable report, concurred in 428.

Flaxseed, bill relating to the inspection of, in the city of Baltimore, received from the senate 556; petition of citizens of Baltimore, counter to the petition of Orndoff & Co. and others, to be allowed to ship, in bulk, contrary to the ordinances of said city 588 bill postponed till May 701.

Floyd, Mary, ordered that the petition of for a, from her husband Joseph Floyd, be withdrawn from the files and referred 36; bill reported 42; amended and passed 57; sent to the senate 64; returned with amendments, which are assented to 209.
