Also, presented a petition of John Mullin, of Montgomery county, praying an act to change his name to that of Samuel Milford,

Which were severally read,---and,

On motion of Mr. Bruff, ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. McLean submitted the following order,

Ordered, that the committee on grievances and courts of justice, be discharged from the further consideration of the petition of Elizabeth McCabe, and that the same be referred to a select committee of three,

Which was twice read,

On motion of Mr. Brown, said order was amended by striking out these words "and that the same be referred to a select committee of three."

On motion of Mr. McLean, said order was then laid on the table,

On motion of Mr. Brown,

Ordered that a committee of seven be appointed, with instructions to bring in a bill supplementary to an act, entitled, an act to establish Magistrates Courts. &c. &c,—continuing the jurisdiction of the County Courts, as they were prior to the passage of said act, until the Magistrates Courts are organised.
