part as parcel of the sinking fund for the redemption of the stock, to be issued under the provisions of this act."

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Duckett, called for the yeas and nays, which were

ordered by the house.

On motion of Mr. Pratt, the house was called and the doorkeeper sent for the absent members, who after a short time had elapsed, returned and reported that he had notified the absent members that their attendance in the house was required.
