

and the Treasurer of the Western Shore is further directed to pay to the Levy Court, or Commissioners exercising the powers of a Levy Court, in each of the aforesaid counties, in quarterly payments, on the first day of January, April, July and October, in each and every year forever thereafter, such sum of money as shall be equal to an interest of six per cent per annum on the principal sum, which shall be allotted to such county as aforesaid, which said payments shall be applied by the Levy Court or Commissioners, in their discretion, to the repair and construction of public roads, to the support of primary schools, or to works of internal improvement, in the respective counties; and the faith of the State is hereby pledged to provide an adequate fund, out of which the said Treasurer shall and may make punctual payments of the aforesaid interest, and,"

The Speaker decided that according to the decision of the house this morning that the amendment was out of order,

From which decision of the chair, Mr. Brown appealed to the house.

Mr. Spence having withdrawn his amendment.

Mr. Ridgely, seconded by two other members that voted in the majority, moved to reconsider the vote of the House reversing the decision of the chair on the point of order,

Resolved in the affirmative.
