By way of Derickson's Cross Roads and Whayley's Ville,

in Worcester county.'

Mr. Spence, seconded by two other members that voted in the majority, moved to reconsider the vote of the house upon the amendment just adopted,

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Long, called for the year and nays, which were or-

dered by the house.
