

of the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company, the commissioners appointed under and by virtue of the joint resolution of the General Assembly of Maryland, number fifteen, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-five, be and they are hereby instructed and required to survey and lay out the rail road contemplated by the provisions of an act, entitled, an act to incorporate the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company, passed at the said session of the General Assembly, so that the said road shall commence at some convenient point on the Wilmington and Susquehanna rail road, and thence run through Cecil, Kent, Queen Ann's, Talbot, Caroline and Somerset counties, to a southern terminus on Pocomoke bay, and that the said Eastern Shore Rail Road Company, shall adopt the said route and bind its corporation to construct their rail road, so as to pass through the said counties, any thing in their said act of incorporation to the contrary notwithstanding,

Which was twice read.

Mr. Burchenal moved that said amendment be rejected, Resolved in the affirmative.
